CHARGER or CHAIRMAN: By the authority vested in me by the National Council of the Boy Scouts of America, it is my privilege and pleasure to pronounce you an Eagle Scout. May the Oath you have taken remain graven on your heart always.

CHAIRMAN: No words of this Court of Honor could do justice to the devotion and patient perseverance with which his Leaders and parents have helped this Eagle Scout toward worthy manhood. In recognition of this, it is very fitting that this young man receive his Eagle Scout Progress Award from the hand of _____ (his mother, father, Scoutmaster, etc...). I now ask _____ the (mother, father, Scoutmaster, etc...) of the Eagle Candidate to pin the Eagle Award on his chest. *(she does so)*

As a rich dividend of fatherly advice and guidance along the trail to the Eagle Rank, I will ask the father now to present his son with the Eagle Scout certificate from the National Council. *(he does so)*

No one will ever know the unnumbered acts of self-sacrifice and helpfulness from the mother of this Eagle Scout, which have led to this moment. As a symbol of what this mother has made possible, the court will now ask the Eagle Scout to present his mother with the miniature Eagle Scout lapel pin. *(he pins it on her lapel)*

As a thanks for the fatherly advice and guidance along the trail, the court will now ask the Eagle Scout to present his father with the Eagle Father's tie clasp. *(he gives it to his father)*

Chairman gives the new Eagle the Scout Handclasp, shakes hands of parents.

May I congratulate you and remind you that Scouting should now become an even greater tie between son and parents, binding you even more closely together as a family. To you Eagle Scout _____, I express the confidence that you will honor Scouting with your life and service, as today Scouting honors you.

You, who provided the long hours of untiring leadership, may you now pass it on to the guiding hand of the parents to pin upon the new Eagle Scout. *Scoutmaster gives to father, who gives to mother, & she pins it on her son.*

And now, Eagle Scout _____, the court of honor gives you this miniature Eagle pin. As your first official duty, you may present it to your mother whom you love, and who has assisted you to attain this highest Scouting Honor. *Eagle pins miniature on his Mother's dress.*

This miniature pin is emblematic of parental faith, love, and encouragement, without which very few Scouts are able to reach this highest position in Scouting. Your mother is privileged to wear it always - as a memento of this occasion.
